INSTRUCTIONS OF USE

About your squeezer...

The squeezer you have purchased is a result of a long research and a loving care passion for our work. We thank you for your choice and assure you that you shall have a laborious partner for many years to come. You can use the JOHNY Squeezer to squeeze lemons, oranges, grape-fruits or any other citrus fruit and enjoy their juices. Before operating your new lemon squeezer please read this manual carefully.

Choosing the right place...

The squeezer should be placed on a level and robust counter away from water. It should be connected to the mains using only a "schugo" plug avoiding the use of cord extensions. In case of power cable damage, this must be replaced by the manufacturer or by an authorized technician, to avoid the danger of bad connection. Make sure that the area around the appliance is dry and oil-free.

Directions of use....

Your squeezer, alike other appliances, should be operated only by adults familiar with its use. Never use the squeezer with wet hands. Place a glass under the juice extraction nozzle. Cut the citrus fruit you wish to squeeze, into halves. Switch on the squeezer and press the fruit gently and progressively onto the extracting cone. Be careful to press the fruit always downwards, while pressing your fingers only gently on the sides of the fruit. After finishing squeezing the fruits wait for a few seconds so that the juice extracted drips are fully to the glass below the nozzle, and then remove the glass. When appliance is at rest, in between usages, please cover the container with the special transparent lid provided for hygiene purposes. At the end of each working day, unplug the appliance.

Some hygiene rules...

When manufacturing the squeezer, we respected the European Hygiene Standards. The container is made of food-safe plastic material for ECO model and stainless steel for RAL and CHROME models. Moreover the cone and the strainer are made of food-safe plastic material, whereas all materials used are recyclable at the end of the appliance life cycle. However, besides the manufacturer's care, we would like to remind you that you should also respect some simple hygiene rules. Use a damp cloth or sponge to clean the body of the appliance, after disconnecting the squeezer from the main power supply. In order to remove the container, pull the cone upwards, and after remove the strainer you can lift the container. After each use and at the end of the day, rinse thoroughly the accessories of the squeezer, dry them off and place them back. In case you notice any damage on the plastic parts, do not use the squeezer until you replace them.

WARNING: DO NOT TRY TO REPAIR THE SQUEEZER BY YOURSELVES. CONTACT THE AUTHORIZED PERSONNEL OR YOUR DEALER. NEVER REPLACE OR CHANGE THE WIRE CORD.
